



ACKNOWLEDGEMENT SECTION FOR EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL PERMIT CITY OF PLATTEVILLE, WISCONSIN

Please carefully read the statements below, initial and provide the required information and signatures.

_____ By submitting an application, the applicant is authorizing the Building Inspector to enter the site to obtain information required for the review of the Erosion and Sediment Control Plan.

_____ I have reviewed Chapter 46 of the City of Platteville Municipal Code regarding erosion and sediment control and I agree to comply with the requirements of the chapter and with all applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations.

_____ I understand that the conditions of the permit are minimum requirements and that, upon site inspection, further measures may be required for compliance with the chapter. I understand that all required erosion and sediment control measures shall be installed and maintained as described in the permit plan. I understand that weekly inspections shall be performed and that weekly inspection reports, along with approved plans, shall be kept on-site.

_____ I understand that the issue of an Erosion and Sediment Control Permit does not relieve applicants of obtaining a Chapter 47 Storm Water Management Permit, if applicable.

_____ I agree to notify the Building Inspector within 2 business day of commencing any land disturbing construction activity and within 5 business days after installation of any BMPs. I agree to maintain all BMPs and if necessary repair any damages to adjoining lands or drainage ways resulting from land disturbing activities at the site until final inspection approval by the City of Platteville.

_____ I agree to inspect the BMPs within 24 hours after each rain of 0.5 inches or more which results in runoff during active construction periods, and at least once each week. Make needed repairs and install additional BMPs as necessary, and document these activities in an inspection log that also includes the date of inspection, the name of the person conducting the inspection, and a description of the present phase of the construction at the site.
