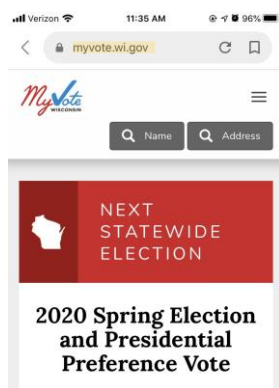


Request an Absentee Ballot on your smartphone

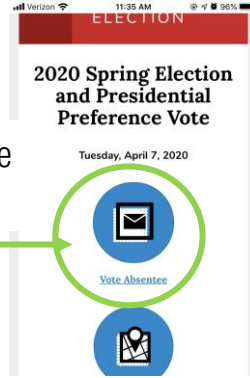
DEADLINE TO REQUEST ABSENTEE: April 2, 2020 at 5:00 PM

1. Go to: myvote.wi.gov
2. Scroll Down

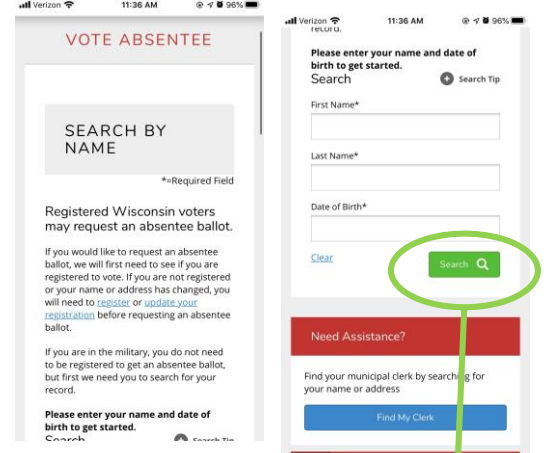

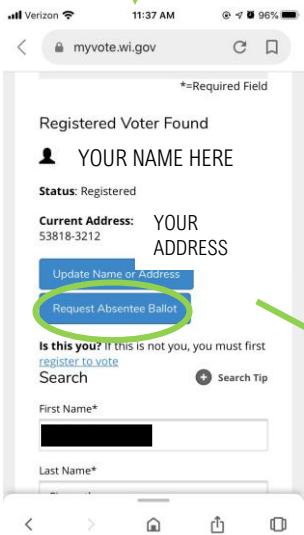
3. Select Vote Absentee



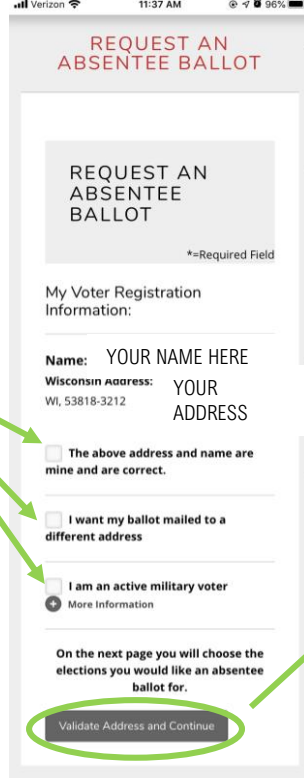
4. Search by name. You will need to scroll down to enter the information. Enter your First Name, Last Name & Date of Birth and click Search



5. If you are registered, your name and current address will be shown. If information is correct, select Request Absentee Ballot

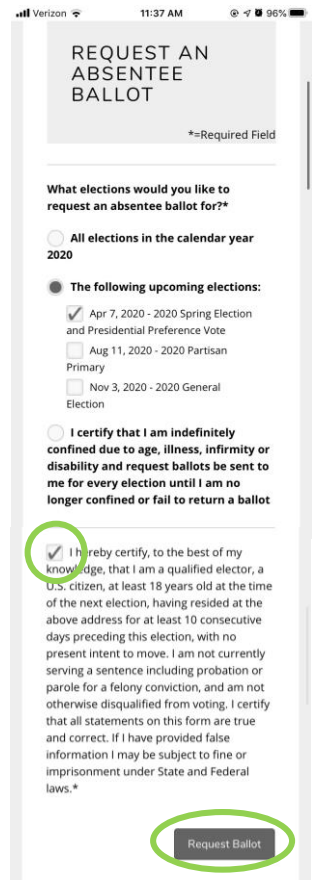


6. Select one option.

8. Choose elections you would like to receive a ballot for.

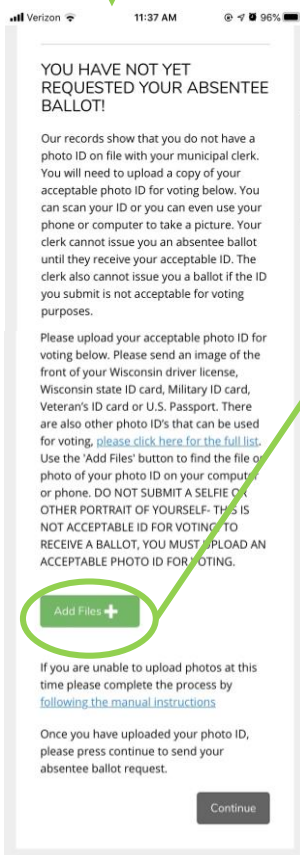


9. Certify. Read carefully.

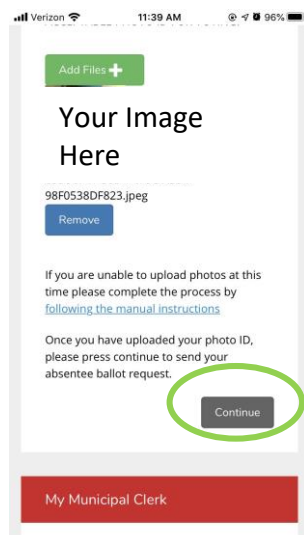
10. Request Ballot

11. If you do not have a photo ID on file, you must add one now.

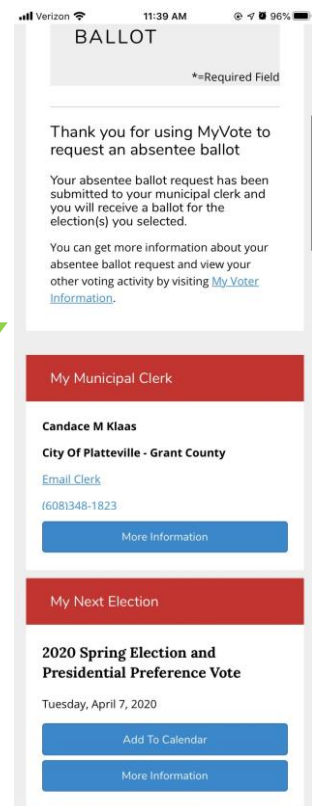
