The Broske Center has rules in place to help reduce the spread of COVID-19; however, we are leaving the final decision to use the facility up to the renter and their invited guests. Please review these rules with all guests using the facility. By signing below, you also agree to follow all rules, accept all risk of utilizing the event center, and to hold harmless the City of Platteville, its employees, agents, and representatives. Please follow all current CDC guidelines.

- Mask are required to be worn in all municipal buildings.
- Practice social distancing.
- Avoid touching common surfaces and wash your hands often with soap and water.
- Cover your mouth and nose when you cough or sneeze.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- Stay home if you feel sick.
- Staff does not sanitize the building or items within, use at your own risk.

Beginning August 23, 2021, masks will be required to be worn by individuals inside all municipal owned buildings which includes the Broske Center. As per CDC guidelines, and, following the earlier guidance, individuals who are performing, eating, or drinking will not be required to wear a mask while engaged in these activities.

It is not the City's intent to patrol gatherings; but we highly encourage individuals to take these precautions for their own health and the health of the community.
