Monday, April 8 & Tuesday, April 9, 2024

- All items must be stacked neatly and be in a pile no larger than 10' x 4' x 4'.
- Brush & yard waste will be included in the spring clean-up. Please have items to curb by Sunday evening and placed separately from weekly garbage. The \$1.00 bags are not required during this special Spring Clean-Up.
- Scrap metal should be stacked neatly, separate from other refuse. Scrap metal and yard waste does not count toward the maximum size limit.

Please have items on curbside by 7:00 a.m. on your normal trash pickup day. This service is provided to one-and two-family dwellings only.

Brush/Limb Wood Chipping

Have your brush to the curb by Sunday

- Wood chipper will circle town during the weeks of the first and third Mondays of the month.
- Chipper can take limbs up to 12" in diameter and as long as possible; long enough so that no more than two people are needed to pull it from the curb to the chipper.
- Brush and limbs must be placed at the curb with the cut end toward the curb and stacked in a neat and orderly fashion. Larger limbs should be grouped together and placed separately from the smaller brush piles. Brush piles that are mixed or thrown every which way will not be picked up until they are piled correctly.

Prohibited Items:

- **all appliances**
- **all electronics, batteries & tires**
- **Refuse from major construction and remodeling projects**
- **oil, anti-freeze, insecticides, and hazardous chemicals**
