### SPECIAL PROVISIONS CONTRACT 6-23 REPLACEMENT OF CITY SIDEWALKS

<u>SCOPE OF WORK:</u> This project consists of removing and replacing damaged sidewalks and such other miscellaneous work as may be called for on the plans or in the specifications.

<u>LOCATION OF THE WORK:</u> The work is in various locations as listed or shown on the attached tabulations and location maps.

All cutting of sidewalk adjacent to commercial properties will have dust control procedures during the cutting operations.

<u>STRUCTURES IN CONCRETE SIDEWALK:</u> All structures in concrete sidewalk, i.e. curbstops and power poles, will have expansion joint material wrapped around it, flush with top of sidewalk.

CURB RAMP DETECTABLE WARNING FIELD: Product shall be installed and provided per Section 705 and 406 of the ANSI Accessible and Usable Buildings and Facilities Code. Materials to be cast iron, manufactured by Neenah (4984-24Q), and color to be red. Two (2' x 2') warning fields will be required per curb ramp.

Place curb ramp detectable warning fields as specified in Section 602.3 of the Wisconsin Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Highway and Structural Construction.

<u>SURFACE RESTORATION:</u> <u>All excavation debris will be removed from the job site at the time of construction. All fill material will be shredded soil with no debris in soil.</u> Provide seed and mulch.

<u>AMOUNT OF WORK:</u> The City of Platteville reserves the right to add or delete work from the project to meet budgetary goals. The addition or deletion of work may result in a change in the quantities as bid. Should the City add or delete work, which is substantially different from the quantity bid, the payment for such work will be negotiated according to the General Conditions.

TIME OF COMPLETION AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES: The City work shall be completed within 90 calendar days from the start date identified on the notice to proceed. The contractor agrees that the City may deduct from monies due the contractor the sum of two hundred (\$200.00) dollars per day as liquidated damages, for each working day beyond the date of completion that the contract remains uncompleted.

<u>WORKING DAY:</u> Working days are defined as Monday through Friday (excluding national holidays), between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Days during which weather conditions prohibit work will not be classed as Working days. Working days will be computed in 1/2-day increments. The Director of Public Works is the sole judge of conditions which prohibit work.

<u>COMPLETION:</u> Completion means that all work, including surface restoration, and clean up has been accomplished. It also includes placement of black dirt, seeding, and mulching; however, touch up seeding and mulching may also be done in the spring, weather dependent. The retainage shall be adjusted to reflect in a proportionate manner the seeding & mulching carried over till spring.

<u>INSURANCE:</u> Contractor shall provide certificate of insurance for the following required coverage.

- 1. Comprehensive General Liability Insurance with bodily injury coverage of not less than \$1,000,000 each person and \$1,000,000 each accident and property damage coverage of not less than \$1,000,000. Comprehensive General Liability to include premises and operations. Contractor's protective liability, products liability including completed operations coverage and contractual liability.
- 2. Personal Injury false arrest, detention or imprisonment or malicious prosecution, libel, slander, defamation, or violation of right of privacy, wrongful entry or eviction or other invasion of right of private occupancy to be included.
- 3. Comprehensive Automobile Liability Insurance with bodily injury coverage of not less than \$500,000 each person and \$1,000,000 each accident and property damage coverage of not less than \$500,000. Comprehensive Automobile Comprehensive Automobile Liability to include all owned and non-owned automobiles.
- 4. In lieu of the above limits, a single limit policy in the amount of\$2,000,000 or a \$2,000,000 Umbrella is accepted.
- 5. Bodily Injury Protection under both comprehensive general and comprehensive automobile forms shall be on an "occurrence" basis.
